(c) The mission of this activity is to control the operations of the Japanese Merchant vessels and Japanese Naval vessels engaged in repatriation service in the most effective manner to maintain a minimum standard of living in Japan and expedite the return of Japanese Prisoners of War and nationals from conquered areas to Japan in order to support the Allied Supreme Commander in the occupation of Japan.

(d) On 29 September Rear Admiral D. B. Beary was directed to implement CinCPac's 150212 and assigned the title of Commander Japanese Repatriation Group (Commander Task Group 50.3) in accordance with Commander FIFTH Fleet's 291221/September.

(e) 2 October 1945

BuPers 022227/October authorized Administrator, Naval Shipping Control Authority for Japanese Merchant Marine (SCAJAP) to order staff officers of Commander Service Squadron SIX to Administrator, Naval Shipping Control Authority for Japanese Merchant Marine (SCAJAP) for duty. Organization of Naval Shipping Control Authority for Japanese Merchant Marine (SCAJAP) Staff proceeded.

(f) 9 October 1945

Rear Admiral D. B. Beary detached as Commander Service Squadron SIX and assumed duty as Administrator, Naval Shipping Control Authority for Japanese Merchant Marine (SCAJAP) in accordance with CinCPac's 072250/October. The headquarters of this activity consist of entire fifth floor of Yokohama Specie Bank Building, Tokyo, Japan, in convenient location to General Headquarters, Supreme Commander Allied Powers and Fleet Liaison Officer, Supreme Commander Allied Powers, communication facilities.

(g) 15 October 1945

SCAP's 150405 to CG, SIXTH Army, CG, EIGHTH Army, CG, XXIV Corps and CG, AFWESPAC notified interested commands that Rear Admiral Beary's headquarters in Tokyo now established as Administrator, Shipping Control Authority for Japanese Merchant Marine and Commander Japanese Repatriation Group with duties exercising direct supervision of Japanese Merchant Ship operations and demilitarized naval vessels assigned repatriation and authorized direct communication.

1. A report on the status of repatriation of Japanese nationals from areas outside Japan proper as of this date is hereby submitted, superseding reference (a). This report includes all Japanese Naval and Merchant vessels engaged in repatriation operations under the control of this command. Japanese vessels not engaged in repatriation operations are not covered by this report.

2. The list of Japanese ports to be used for debarkation of Japanese repatriates given in reference (a), was rescinded by SCAP dispatch 171133 of October (ZA X 7148) and the following list established.

- MAIZURU
- SHIMONSEKI
- SASEBO (For Allied Shipping Only)
- SENZAKI
- KAGOSHIMA
- KURE
- HAKATA
- URAGA
- YOKOHAMA
- MOJI
- HAKODATE (Established When Ordered)

MOJI is temporarily not being used pending clearing of mines from KANNON Straits.

3. At present, Japanese are being repatriated from four principal areas: KOREA, RYUKYUS, PHILIPPINES and the PACIFIC ISLANDS under the control of Commander in Chief Pacific Fleet. Short range shipping is being used for the Korean Shuttle service, the Ryukyus and the Bonins. Long range shipping is being used for the Central Pacific and the Philippines on a present average of 60 percent to Central Pacific Islands and 40 percent to the Philippines. As of this date, the balance is considerably in favor of the Central Pacific Islands, but by 1 November, it is expected that the 60 - 40 balance will have been reached.

4. Three ships (capacity 15,000) have just been assigned to commence repatriation operations from China. In accordance with SCAP dispatch 161327 of October (CA X 53394), it is expected in the near future to reallocate long range shipping as follows:

CHINA . . . . .	18,500 passenger capacity or 30 percent.
POA . . . . .	15,000 passenger capacity or 25 percent.
PHILIPPINES . . . . .	12,500 passenger capacity or 20 percent.
Islands under AUSTRALIAN control . . . . .	14,000 passenger capacity or 25 percent.

5. The following is the status of repatriation by areas:

(a) KOREA.

Repatriation of Japanese POW's from U.S. controlled areas of Southern Korea should be completed by 23 October and from Quelpart Island by 15 November. As of this date, approximately 470,000 Japanese civilians remain to be repatriated from Southern Korea, which it is believed can be brought back by the end of the year. As shipping is no longer needed for the Korean Shuttle, it will be diverted to China and the Ryukyus. Eighteen (18) Japanese Army transports allocated by reference (a), to the Philippine service, have been reassigned to the Korean and Ryukyus shuttle runs since they are considered unseaworthy for long range trips. Twenty (20) U.S. LST's have also begun repatriation runs between Korea and Japan, each hauling about 1000 persons each trip.

(b) RYUKYUS.

Evacuation of the Ryukyus is proceeding in accordance with the recommendations of Commanding General 10th Army, according to the following priority.

SAKISHIMA GUNTO and DAITOS	100%	6800
ISHIGAKI JIMA	75%	6225
KIKAIGA SHIMA	100%	2100
MIYAKO	75%	19500

This priority is based on the necessity for removing Japanese from certain areas in order to maintain a minimum subsistence economy through the coming winter. It is expected that the rate of evacuation can be speeded up with shipping eventually diverted from the Korean service.

(c) CHINA.

Three large passenger vessels have just been assigned for repatriation of Japanese from China. They will also carry Chinese from Japan on the outgoing trip. It is also expected that U.S. LST's possibly as many as 100, will be used for this haul. Order of evacuation of Japanese from specific areas of China, will depend on the recommendations of the Chinese Government.

(d) FORMOSA.

The Chinese Government is not yet ready to receive Formosans from Japan or to return Japanese from Formosa.


(e) PHILIPPINES.

Diversion of the eighteen (18) Japanese Army transports from the Korean run has been compensated for by the assignment of two large passenger ships to the Philippines. Other large long range vessels may be assigned to the Philippine run. It is also anticipated that as many as 70 U.S. cargo ships returning empty from the Philippines will be used to haul Japanese to Japan.

(f) PACIFIC OCEAN AREA.

Alleviation of starvation in nearly all Central Pacific Islands has been accomplished. Marcus has been completely evacuated. It is expected that Wake and the Marshalls will be completely cleared by 1 November. Future assignments of repatriation vessels to the Central Pacific will be made in accordance with the recommendations of Commander Marianas.

(g) Evacuation of all other areas is dependent upon the completion of arrangements with the Australian, British, Dutch, French, Chinese and Russian authorities concerned. No arrangements have been completed as yet.

## ENCLOSURE (B)

Status of Repatriation of Japanese Nationals by Area

The following table indicates the status of repatriation of Japanese nationals by area as of 19 October 1945. The figures in the second column represent the best available information as to the number of Japanese present in each place as of about 1 September 1945. For areas under the control of Commander in Chief Pacific Fleet - Commander in Chief Pacific Ocean Area and the Philippines, these figures are proving to be fairly accurate. Figures on China and Korea are merely estimates. Column three includes only those repatriates who have actually landed in Japan. Column five includes all Japanese either already picked up but not yet returned to Japan or whose evacuation is definitely scheduled. Since experience is showing that evacuation ships are lifting considerably more persons than they had originally been thought capable of, it is believed that this figure is as much as 15 - 20 percent underestimated.

1. Enclosure (A) is submitted for information. It represents the best available information from the Japanese Government as to the status of the Japanese Merchant Marine operating under the control of this command.

2. Attention is invited to the following points:

(a) Only those ships being operated by the Japanese under the direction of this command are included. No Japanese vessel caught by the surrender outside Japan and not yet returned to Japan is included in this list. Japanese Army and Naval vessels (except former merchant vessels) are also excluded.

(b) Only those damaged vessels the extent of damage to which is sufficiently light as to make their repair practicable are included in this list.

(c) With two exceptions, no ships under 100 gross tons are included. Also all wooden vessels are excluded, regardless of size. Certain special craft such as lighthouse vessels, fishing supervising vessels, training craft, harbor construction vessels and the like are not included. Fishing vessels are not listed.

3. An attempt has been made to do away as much as possible with the confusion resulting from the fact that many Japanese vessels have the same or very similar names. In some cases the Japanese have already numbered vessels of the same name. For example, "No. 3 Nissan Maru" and "No. 4 Nissan Maru" are correct Japanese-registry names. Where no such distinction exists in the Japanese naming system, this command has arbitrarily assigned numbers, by adding Roman numerals to the names of identically-named vessels. The Japanese have been instructed to adopt this numbering system but it will undoubtedly take some time before this system is adopted universally. To avoid further confusion resulting from accidental misspellings and garblings in despatches, each vessel has been assigned a code designation (e.g., T012). Commencing November 5, 1945, this command will commence using the code designation along with the name of each vessel in despatches and serials. It is requested that other commands do the same.

4. Vessels are listed alphabetically with the exception of tankers, which are listed alphabetically under the letter "X".

5. You will be informed in the future of changes or additions to this roster.
