

Jap POW Camp Officer Hanged

YOKOHAMA, April 26.—(LP)—
Japanese Lieut. Kei Yuri, ex-com-
mandant of the Omuta prisoner of
war camp, was hanged on the gal-
lows of Sugamo prison at 5:15 a. m.
today. He was the first Japanese
war criminal to be executed in
Japan proper.

Yuri was found guilty by an
Eighth army military tribunal of
ordering Pvt. Moah C. Heard, Sa-
linas, Cal., bayoneted to death,
and of permitting Marine Corp.
James C. Pavlokos, Chicago, to
starve to death in prison.
