Interpreter at Shina Gawa Camp Hospital

KAWASAKI 3D CAMP
(Midway between Tokyo and Yokohama)

NAKAMURA Tomoki or Tomoyoshi
Lieutenant Camp Commandant 3D Tokyo 28 Feb 45 to
12 May 45. Probably same man who was commandant
at 15D Niigata.

TAKI nicknamed "Snake Eyes"
Civilian guard or boss at Nippon Kokan Ship yards.

SENDAI I CAMP
(About 2 miles from Onahama on East coast of island and about 100
miles north of Tokyo)

TSUDA nicknamed "THE FROG"
Veterans Guard on staff on Sendai I from May to
Sep. 45.

OMINE CAMP COAL MINE
(Close to Kawasaki; Fukuoka District about 40 miles from city
of Fukuoka on Island of Kyushu)

ASHIDA Sgt. i/c medical arrangements at Omine.

KAWAHARA nicknamed "EARS"
Overseer at mine at Omine.

TAKAMIA nicknamed "PUSS IN BOOTS" "SMILING JACK"
Civilian mine boss at Omine.

NIIGATA 5B and 15D in City of Niigata
(Includes civilians from Rinko Coal Company, Marutsu Stevedoring
Company and Shintitsu Foundry in Niigata).

ABBE nicknamed "PADDLEFOOT" (EIPIE)
Civilian boss at Rinko Coal Co.

HASHIMOTO (HASAMOTO); (HOTSUMOTO) nicknamed "LIVER LIPS"
Civilian boss at Rinko Coal Co.

ITO Sgt. SEIICHI
Camp staff at 5B Niigata.

KOBAYA (KOBIA) - nicknamed "SQUEEKY"
Civilian boss at Marutsu Stevedoring Co.

KOBAYASHI nicknamed "ALLEY CAT"

Civilian boss at factory, nickel factory.

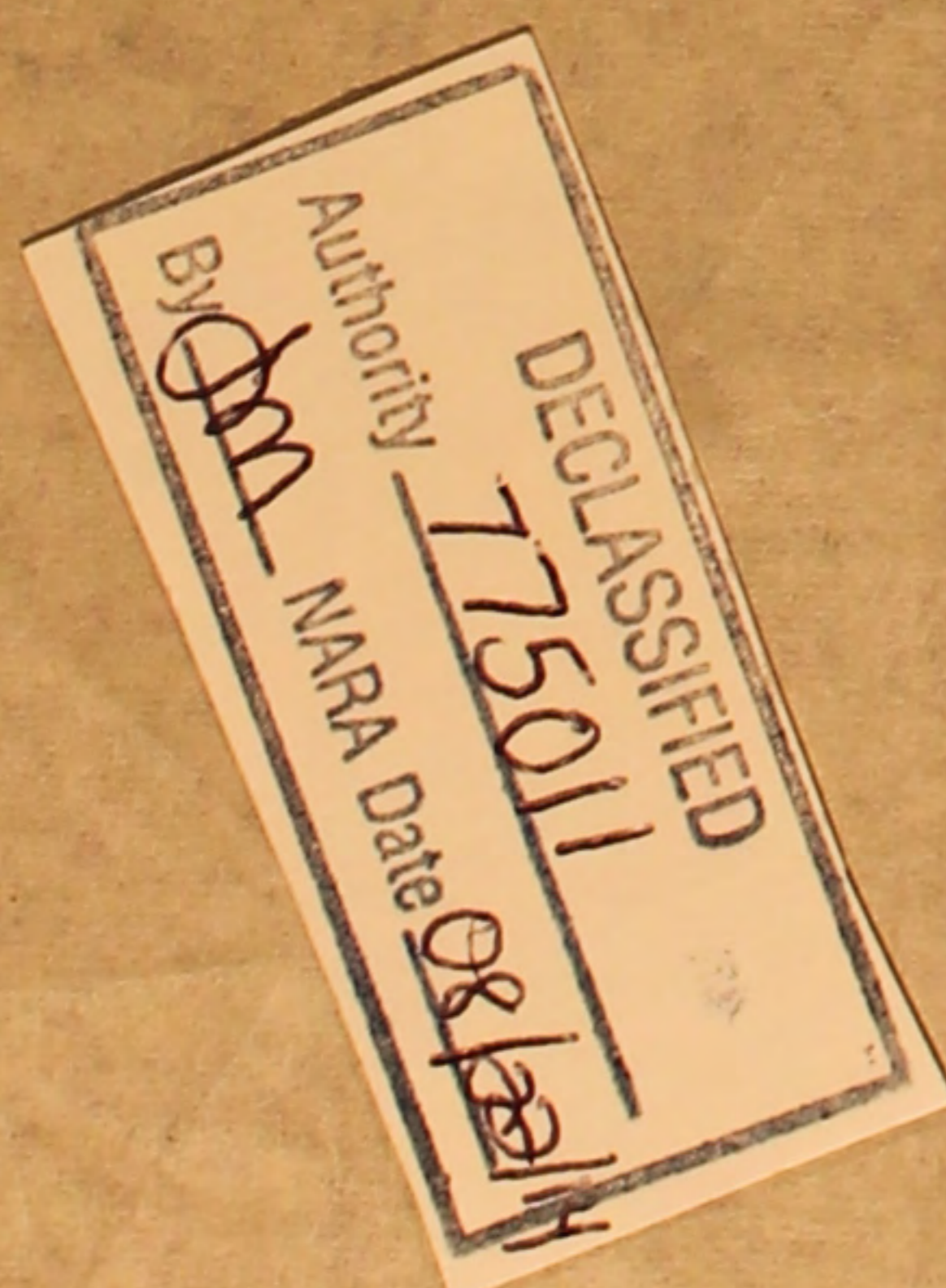
KOWAKITA nicknamed "LIVER LIPS"
Interpreter at nickel mine and factory and camp

MORITA nicknamed "GAMMY HAND"
Veterans guard on camp staff at Oeyama.

NAKAYAMA "In Siigama Prison"
Sgt. i/c medical administration at Oeyama until
Nov. 44

SHEAGOWA
Civilian boss at Oeyama nickel refinery.

TANAKA nicknamed the "SQUIRREL"
Veterans guard on camp staff at Oeyama.



ONINE CAMP 5

(Close to ^Kwasaki, Fukuoka District, about 40 miles from City of Fukuoka on Island of Kyushu)

- Captain KANEKO *Directive*
Camp commandant from December 1943 or January 1944 to March 1945.
- Captain TANAKA *Directive*
Camp commandant from January 1943 to September 1943 ? *Yanase*.
- Sergeant KOBASHI *Directive*
Second in command of camp under Lieut. Tanaka.
- Sergeant UCHIDA *Directive*
S Second in command of camp under Capt. Kaneko.
- MARUHAMMA
Civilian guard. *Directive*
- ONDA *Directive*
Nicknamed "BROWN BOMBER" civilian guard (picture enclosed).

MARUMI CAMP

(Suburbs of City of Nagoya)

- Lieut. TANAKA
Camp commandant September, 1943 to May 1945 and took party to Toyama Camp.
- TANAKA
Nicknamed "FISH FACE" a guard at camp, not to be confused with Lieut. Tanaka.

SUMA CAMP

(100 miles due west of Tokyo)

- Lieut. Junsho HAYASHI *Custodian*
Camp commandant from May 1945 to September, 1945. (Address: 479 Motoyoshi-Cho, Nagano-Shi, Japan).
