3. This makes a total of eight (-8) men who must be transported by litter or truck if there is much walking required. Of course, men get sick each day

and well each day. However, I am fairly certain that the number of litter cases will not increase more than four (4). Therefore, if we plan on twelve (12) litters, we can be certain of being able to take care of all present sick men, plus all new sick men.

4. Also, the following seventeen (17) men can walk a moderate distance -- four (4) miles -- unaided, but might have trouble trying to walk any further: --


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
