1. SANTO TOMAS INTERNMENT CAMP

(Camp No. 1 - Manila)

- A. CENSUS LIST. Civilian Internment Camp No. 1.
As of December 25, 1944. American Nationals.

NOTE: This list includes those interned because of serious illness in the following hospitals: Philippine General, National Psychopathic, San Jose, San Juan de Dios, and Philippine Tuberculosis. Also included are those imprisoned at Muntinlupa Prison.

This is the last official census made. No internees released from camp after this date for any reason, nor moved from hospitals or prison, with the exception of those taken out of Camp by the Japanese and subsequently executed. See 4-A Nos. 379, 380, 381 and 382.

- B. List of Children born in Manila Internment Camp since 1942.
(Names also included in Census List A above)

- C. List of Persons on Conditional Release from Manila Internment Camp, as of December 31, 1944.

NOTE: This list consists of those officially interned in their homes by order of the Japanese because of old age, ill health, etc. and a few assigned to take care of them. Several children are listed in this group as students. Also included are those imprisoned at Muntinlupa Prison, whose names also appear in Census List A above.

Many of these internees were killed or injured in the Battle of Manila. Exact number unknown. Due to confusion during and immediately following the Battle, their names do not appear on official survivor or death lists. (It is positively known that the following lost their lives: Ada Cook Burke, Blanche Walker Jurika, Walter Howard Loving, Sr., Carl Edward Nathorst, Charlotte Gwinne Nathorst, Gwinne Trego Nathorst.)

This is the last official list of this group of internees. No releases from Camp to this group nor none brought into camp from this group after this date.

This list covers the death of Santo Tomas Internees, those who died in Davao before Davao Camp was transferred to Santo Tomas, and those who died in the Baguio Internment Camp. Deaths in the Los Banos camp are not included in this list.

Internees who died shortly after Liberation whose names do not appear on Death List 4-A above, names will be found in the official records of the Army deposited in St. Louis.

Names of Internees on "Conditional Release" who were killed in the Battle of Manila will not appear in Death List 4-A above, nor will their names be included in official Army records deposited in St. Louis. See 1-C Note.
