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On 22 April 1947, GLO Memo #2979 was received at the Legal Section in reference to Legal Section Check Sheet #7431 and GLO Memo #2932, which is being transmitted to the Criminal Registry Division with their copy of this report and which supplied the following information:

In regard to your conversation on 21 May 1947 concerning subject matter, the clues are received by this office from the Prisoner of War Information Bureau and the First and Second Demobilization Bureau. After examining these clues, we translate them into English and will submit a report as soon as possible.

The above conference referred to consisted of explaining to the Japanese, the complete inadequacy of the initial report and demanding that a more complete report be submitted to this Division concerning the handling of Allied Airmen.

On 1 August 1947, GLO Memo #6019 was received in reference to the above GLO Memos and to Legal Section's Memo which supplied an additional roster of Prisoners of War transferred from the Tokyo Kempai Tai. This roster is being transmitted to the Criminal Registry Division with their copy of this report and reads as follows:

4. Strike out all of Index No 126.

2. Five of the persons handled by the Northeastern Army District were attached to the English Mobile Unit. All the rest, whose nationalities are not recorded, are Americans.
3. For the most part, the prisoners were routed through the Tokyo KEMPEITAI (Later, the Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters), and then placed in the Tokyo PW Internment Camp at GNORI.
4. The triangle (TH Δ) in the remarks column indicates those persons who had received verdicts of non-prosecution (because of the termination of the war) by the Eastern District Army Military Tribunal.
5. It is assumed that those who were not under the jurisdiction of the Eastern District Army and yet were handled by its Military tribunal, should have been dealt with by the tribunal of either the General Defense Command or First Army General Headquarters, but were transferred to the charge of the Eastern District Army Military Tribunal.

6. The person responsible for the handling of these persons at the Tokyo PW Internment Camp was the camp superintendent, Col SAKABA, Kaname ().

Details regarding
the Integration of Command Functions Tokyo KEMPEITAI
and the Eastern District KEMPEITAI
(Eastern District Demobilization Liaison Office)

The homeland organization of the KEMPEITAI not only placed the KEMPEI Headquarters in TOKYO which supervised KEMPEI on the homeland, but also underwent several changes in local organizations.

In the beginning, the local organization consisted generally of designating the jurisdictional district of division as the KEMPEITAI's jurisdictional area, assigning a KEMPEITAI to each of these areas with each KEMPEITAI sending out squads (SUNTAI) to the vital localities and detachments as necessity arose. Consequently, the Tokyo KEMPEITAI was set up in TOKYO. At that time, the Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters did not exist. As, on 1 Apr 45, the command relationship was defined as Army District --- Divisional District --- Regimental District, the organization of the KEMPEI later underwent a revision to comply with this. Essentially the following changes took place..

1. The former KEMPEITAI jurisdictional area was renamed KEMPEITAI district.
2. The former KEMPEITAI coast renamed the District KEMPEITAI. As a general rule, one such District KEMPEITAI was established in each prefecture.
3. New entities known as Northern District, Northeastern Eastern District, TOKAI, Central District, CHUGOKU, SHIKOKU, and Western District KEMPEITAI Headquarters were established. They not only supervised the District KEMPEITAI in the respective Army districts, but they, themselves carried out the missions of a district KEMPEITAI for an area within these Army districts (e.g. Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters and TOKYO).

As the above changes occurred, the Tokyo KEMPEITAI ceased to exist, and the Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters was born. Not only did this Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters supervise all the District KEMPEITAI within the Eastern Army District, but it also carried out the functions of the Tokyo District KEMPEITAI. (Consequently the Tokyo District KEMPEITAI did not exist as such).

The foregoing has been a discussion of the relationship between the Tokyo KEMPEI and the Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters. However, as was clarified in the earlier statement, the Eastern District KEMPEITAI and the Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters refer to the same thing. Moreover, it is clear that no integration of command could possibly have existed between the Tokyo KEMPEITAI and the Eastern District KEMPEITAI Headquarters since they did not exist concurrently.

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The above information has not been fully evaluated at the Tokyo office and is being set out so that this information can be directed to interested parties.

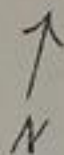

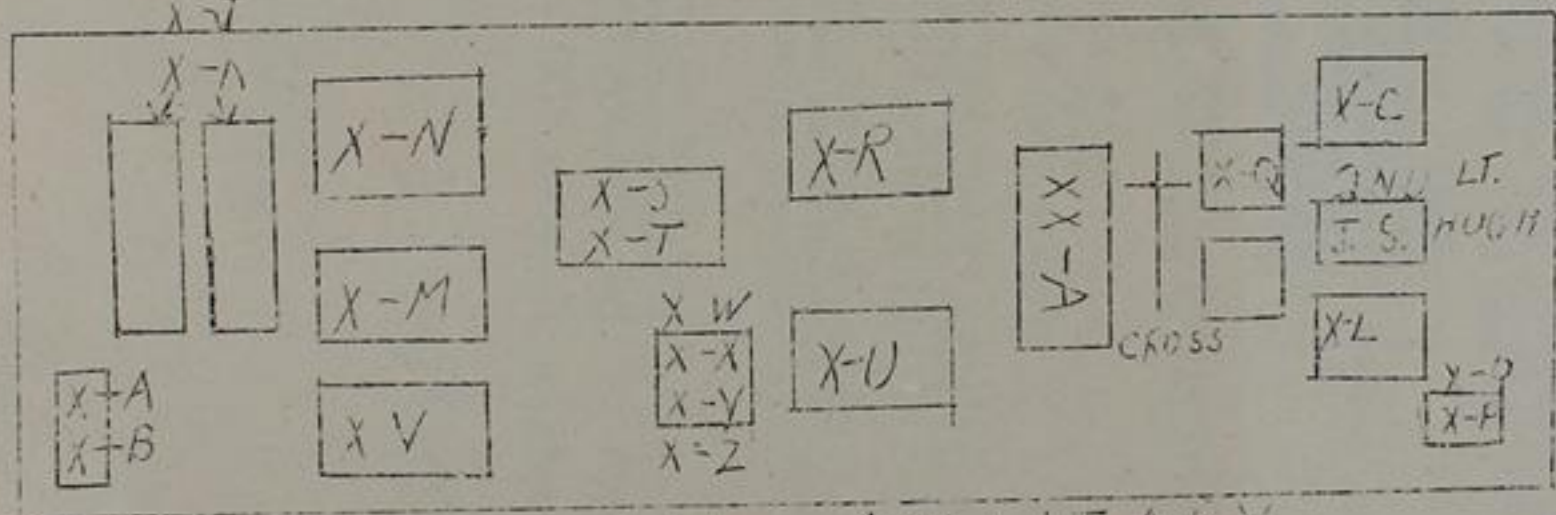
