All Prisoners of War and Civilian Internees under custody of the Japanese Imperial Navy are interned in foreign territories under Japanese occupation. The location of the internment camp, number of persons and nationality, respectively, are enclosed herewith on sheet No.1 and No. 2. The list of names of the Prisoners of War and Civilian Internees, the latest edition of which was compiled as of December 1st, 1944, was completely destroyed by fire when the Office of the Naval Ministry suffered air-raid and burned. As it is practically impossible to gather necessary materials in Tokyo owing to difficulties of communication we have instructed the Japanese Naval Authorities in each locality to deliver the list and other necessary informations on the spot to the Allied authorities.
