REFERENCE NOTES TO ACCOMPANY REPORT ON SIGNAL AIR WARNING CO  
ROSTER OF ENLISTED MEN AND OFFICERS

1. McDonnell, Carl F. Chg. address to 114 E. Westmoreland St. Phila., Pa. According to 1st Sgt. Page this man was wounded in action at Aglaloma Point by bursting grenade. Awarded Purple Heart commended for attacking enemy position single handed while wounded.
2. Awarded Silver Star 4-14-42, wounded 4-16-42 left leg, left hip, and left jaw by shell fragments. Award of Purple Heart published 4-22-42.
3. Was told orally by Lt. Blizzard that he had been promoted to Corporal just prior to 4-9-42. This refers to Hinds, James D.
4. Lt. Hutchison-Eng. Sgts, Temple and Alschuler, and Pvt Kirshner destroyed A.W. equipment Top Side correigidor during enemy shell fire night of 5-5-42. Lt. Wimer stated his intention to recommend silver star but had no opportunity according to Stg. Temple. (Hoten '45)
5. Killed in action at Iba 12-8-41 at their post of duty; Moore, Shaffron, by Sgt. Temple--Hoten.
6. Wounded at Iba 12-3-41 and received Purple Heart Award; Rossell, Vasey, Thomas, and Brodjinski. Wounded on Correigidor later Brodjinski received 2nd Award. according to Sgt. Temple at Hoten 45.
7. Dean Nicholson, 1st Lt. Eng., (Home address; 1424 E. Ward St. Seattle, Wash.) was mining Engr in North Luzon before war. Commissioned in Army and active in that area with E.B. He knew many men of Lt. Arnold's unit up there and supplied info of them for this record at Hoten. On June 14 1942 he, Harkaway and 3 others left N. Luzon in small boat, were picked up by Japanese destroyer taken to Alakong, Pescadores, thru Takao to Hosan, Taiwan June 28th to Heito Aug 2nd; Harkaway remained at Heito but Lt. N. left for Shirakawa in Oct. (Capt. Cushing likewise commissioned and active in North Luzon.
8. Service Records of Company buried in Bataan near Company area. Sgt. Page had in his possession at Hoten the Co's morning reports. Co. Personnel clerks were Michael and O'Rourke. Co Clerk was Jones.
