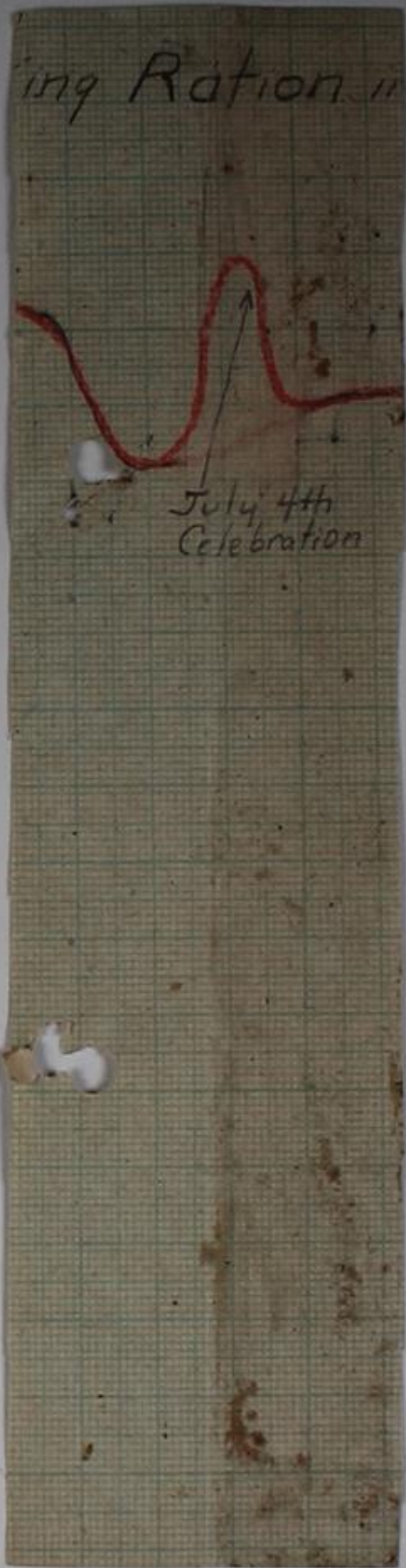
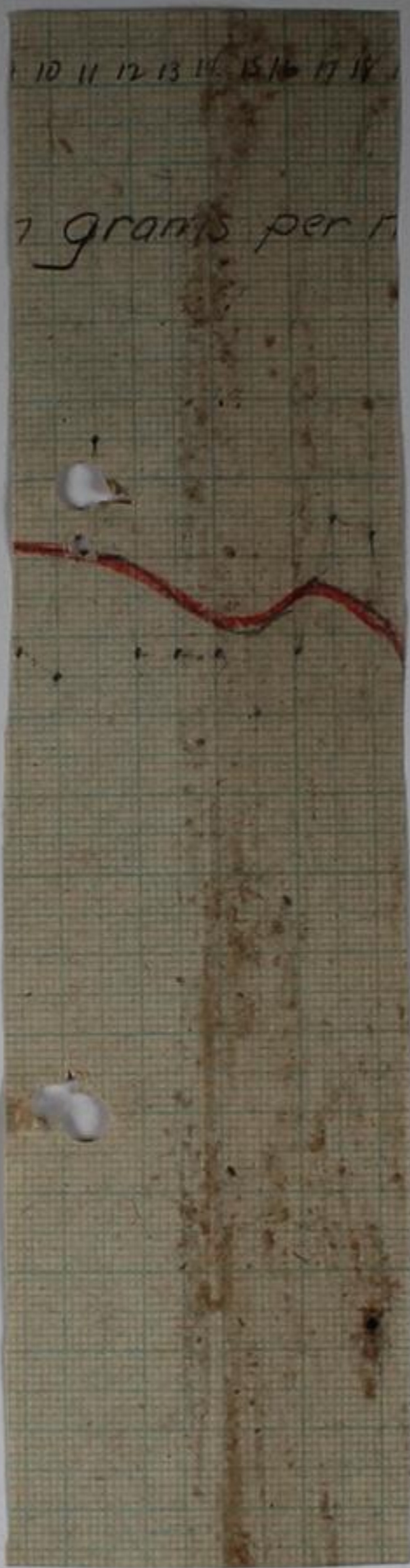

SUGGESTIONS FOR PRESERVATION OF CLOTHING

- 1) Shake dust from clothes before and after wearing to help preserve them.
- 2) Those who have no time to wash ought to spray and dry the sweaty clothes.
- 3) Keep in mind that frequent washing improves the health.
- 4) Most important to disinfect bedding by sunlight.
- 5) Wipe away with the miso soup those clothes stained with nicotine.
- 6) Repair clothing as much as possible before getting threadbare.
- 7) Soap weakens the clothing fabric, clothes may be kept clean by washing often in hot water.

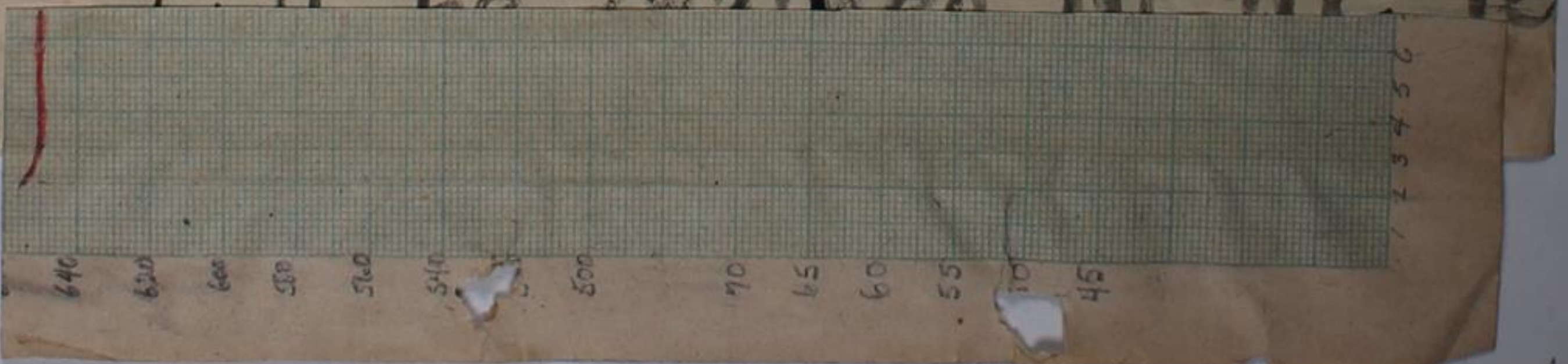
