Legal Section Informational Summary No. 269.

SUBJECT: U. S. vs Taichi SATO

Taichi SATO, wartime commander of a Yokohama Japanese Prisoner of War Camp, was sentenced to eight years' imprisonment at hard labor by a Yokohama Eighth Army Military Commission today, 4 May 1948.

Tried under charge and specifications signed by Alva C. Carpenter, Chief of the Legal Section, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, SATO was found guilty of numerous atrocities during his command of Tokyo Area Prisoner of War Camp Number 13-D, Yokohama, Honshu, Japan. The accused served at the camp from December 1944 through April 1945, holding the rank of lieutenant.

SATO was found guilty of personally beating and mistreating Allied prisoners, as well as ordering and permitting his subordinates to do likewise. He was said to have inflicted especially brutal beatings following American B-29 raids, sometimes using the blade of his sword to hit prisoners. In addition he was found guilty of misappropriating Red Cross supplies intended for the prisoners and of permitting his subordinates to misappropriate Red Cross and other supplies.

Prisoners at the camp were forced to perform arduous labor at the Asano Docks even when ill and physically unfit. The protests of the Allied medical officer, Captain Julian T. Saldivar (2805 Lafayette Avenue, Austin, Texas) were unavailing in getting seriously ill prisoners excused from work. SATO is said to have stated that the internees at the camp were captives and not prisoners of war and hence could be treated as slaves. The defendant was also found guilty of failing to provide adequate and humane medical care and attention for the internees at the camp.

Prosecuting the case against SATO for Legal Section was Mr. Max Schiffman of 2155 East 24th Street, Brooklyn, New York.

Affidavit of Capt J. A. Steward

1. On 24 Dec 41, on receipt of orders to evacuate Manila, conference held by head of Department
2. Decided to have several key officers behind to "keep close check on activities of Japs" & to obtain information for American forces.
3. Officers so selected were to turn selves in to Japs on evasions
4. Each given a release from Public "to be used only in case of extreme danger"
5. Were ordered to report to Navy immediately on their return
6. Was clearly understood all such officers were to continue on active duty.
7. Releases were for "cover up purposes only".
8. Officers remained in Manila but would not have done so had they been separated from service.

Legal Section Informational Summary No. 269.

SUBJECT: U. S. vs Taichi SATO

Taichi SATO, wartime commander of a Yokohama Japanese Prisoner of War Camp, was sentenced to eight years' imprisonment at hard labor by a Yokohama Eighth Army Military Commission today, 4 May 1948.

Tried under charge and specifications signed by Alva C. Carpenter, Chief of the Legal Section, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, SATO was found guilty of numerous atrocities during his command of Tokyo Area Prisoner of War Camp Number 13-D, Yokohama, Honshu, Japan. The accused served at the camp from December 1944 through April 1945, holding the rank of lieutenant.

SATO was found guilty of personally beating and mistreating Allied prisoners, as well as ordering and permitting his subordinates to do likewise. He was said to have inflicted especially brutal beatings following American B-29 raids, sometimes using the blade of his sword to hit prisoners. In addition he was found guilty of misappropriating Red Cross supplies intended for the prisoners and of permitting his subordinates to misappropriate Red Cross and other supplies.

Prisoners at the camp were forced to perform arduous labor at the Asano Docks even when ill and physically unfit. The protests of the Allied medical officer, Captain Julian T. Saldivar (2805 Lafayette Avenue, Austin, Texas) were unavailing in getting seriously ill prisoners excused from work. SATO is said to have stated that the internees at the camp were captives and not prisoners of war and hence could be treated as slaves. The defendant was also found guilty of failing to provide adequate and humane medical care and attention for the internees at the camp.

Prosecuting the case against SATO for Legal Section was Mr. Max Schiffman of 2155 East 24th Street, Brooklyn, New York.
